



## **Château Tire Pé**

**The story of Château Tire Pé began in 1997 when husband and wife David and Hélène Barrault took over a small, picturesque vineyard. Perched gracefully in the Gironde-sur-Dropt region, the estate boasts fantastic southern exposures and overlooks the winding Garonne River below.**

**The chateau itself takes its name from a rather colourful local tale. “Tire Pé” references the steep, arduous hill leading up to the estate, a climb so demanding that small animals are famously said to “leave a little something behind” from the exertion before making their way to the top.**

**Blessed with rich clay and limestone soils, the site offered immense potential. Today, the Barraults dedicate themselves to farming their vines organically, working in deep respect with the land to ensure the vineyard ecosystem remains vibrant and healthy.**

**In the cellar, David and Hélène share a philosophy of purity, patience, and restraint. Great care is taken to gently extract the supple fruit and earthy elegance that Bordeaux is so well known for into each cuvée they produce. Rather than forcing the wine or over-working the must, they simply coax out its natural characteristics, allowing the specific terroir of their pocket of the region to shine with absolute transparency.**
