

## **Isle Saint Pierre**

**Vigneron: Julien Henry**

**Location: Arles, Rhône**

**The story of Domaine Isle Saint Pierre is rooted in an extraordinary and unexpected location: a small island in the Rhône River. Founded in 1927 by Julien Henry's pioneering great-grandfather, the sprawling 200-hectare estate sits right in the heart of the wild Camargue Regional Nature Park near Arles. Today, as a fourth-generation vigneron, Julien carries on the family's legacy, working in total harmony with the island's abundant biodiversity and surrounding wetlands.**

**Managing an estate of this size requires a deep respect for the environment, and Julien tends to the vines using strict organic farming practices. The unique island terroir is defined by deep, well-draining sedimentary soils comprised of sand and silt. While the southern French sun brings the grapes to perfect ripeness, the summer heat is beautifully tempered by the cooling influence of the surrounding waters and the fierce, cleansing winds of the Mistral, which naturally keep the vines healthy and free of disease.**

**In the cellar, the philosophy is all about preserving the natural freshness and vitality born from the vineyard. Julien focuses on crafting pure, vibrant, and honest "bistro-style" cuvées rather than heavy, oak-laden wines. Because of their unique proximity to the sea and river, the wines often possess a subtle, salty edge and a zippy acidity that feels distinctly place-bound, qualities rarely found in mainland Rhône wines.**
